They go undercover as a nun and priest, but their presence, combined with the addition of a new nun-Sister Mary Catherine (Hannah Ali), spurs paranoia throughout the convent that spies have been sent from Rome (Italy) to shut them down. Wine and secrets are inevitably spilled as everyone tries to preserve the convent and reconnect with lost loves. The rest of the cast includes: Mark Hanna (Father Chenille), Erik Carlson (George the Groundskeeper), and Michele Buday (Mother Superior).
