## **Upcoming Workshops Sound Workshop Apr. 15**

Sound Design - Saturday, April 15th, 10AM - 2PM, presented by Joel Lord -Joel is an award-winning Sound Designer with more than 20 years' experience in Community, Semi-Professional, and Professional Theatre. He has taught sound design and technology workshops at Regional Festivals, the TANYS Festival, and at the Southeastern Conference, ranging Theatre from introductory design through advanced wireless microphone troubleshooting techniques.

Workshop description: Beyond The Script There is a whole world of sound beyond the stage directions written into a script, once you know where to look for it. Using real production examples, we will examine where sound can be used to enhance a production, and by doing so bring out the real art of sound design rather than just playing a few effects.

#### Makeup Workshop Apr. 29

Will is the Head Makeup and Special FX Coordinator at the New York State Preparedness Training Center. He has worked on over 50 theatrical productions as a makeup artist for a number of colleges, high schools, community theatres and community organizations. After last year's workshop on Makeup, Mr. Lanfear left the attendees wanting more, so we are providing this workshop as a result of this feedback:

**Workshop Description:** This workshop will cover the basics of stage makeup. How to create texture, bruises and how to age a character, and how to create special effects. A portion of this workshop will be a hands on makeup teaching session.
