RCT sadly announces that Mr. Fred Normand, the last original member of Rome Community Theater, passed away on November 2nd. Fred was well known around RCT holding many positions throughout the years. He was most famous for the sets he designed and built and the many hours he spent leading projects to expand and enhance RCT and its theater building. Most of the patrons know his name, since he also worked every show when not backstage as the 50-50 raffle chairman and season ticket chairman.

At its November 3rd meeting, the RCT board suggested that the new theater storage area being planned be named "Fred's Shed". They also approved constructing a small table or cupboard for the 50-50 drawings with a memorial plaque.
