Thanks to a generous donation from **The Rotary Club of Rome**, **NY**, we are proud to present our new Box Office and Ticketing system, **Ludus**, which allows for many additional online features to help streamline our services. However, PayPal is no longer part of the payment system.

#### **FLEX PASS HOLDERS**

You will receive a code (pass code) in your packet with your Flex Tickets. This code will allow you to go online and book your own day/seat. You may still use 1 pass or several passes for any season show. Instructions are in the packet and will be sent via email. There is a spot on the flex ticket to write the pass code on; please do so--especially if you are bringing it to the theater to redeem. This will be a big help!

#### RESERVED SEAT SEASON TICKET HOLDERS

You will also receive a code (pass code) in your packet. This code will allow you to CHANGE Seats/Day online yourself, if needed. Instructions will be forwarded to you also.

If they get lost, it's not a problem; we can look them up, but it will make changes much easier if you have them handy.
